Respected Madam,


Vide our letters TF-31/1, dt-03-08-2018 and 13-09-2018 we solicited your kind attention for wage revision of casual labourers on the basis of 7<sup>th</sup> CPC recommendations and its implementations. The corporate office stand of linking the issue with the 3<sup>rd</sup> PRC implementation in the BSNL is neither logical nor justified. We may add that the officers having Govt status engaged in the company are enjoying the fruits of the CPC but the low paid contingent employees are being denied their rightful claims through irrelevant reasons.

It is added that the formation of any committee for the wage revision of casual labourers/TSMs is not at all needed as principles are already laid down in corporate office letter No.-11-3/2016-LE, dt-22-08-2018. We feel sorry to record here that the voice of poor and downtrodden are not only being ignored but suppressed also in the corporate office.

Kindly, therefore, intervene to get the matter resolved as justice delayed is justice denied.
