Subject: Applicability of GPF/EPF scheme to the TSMS regularised on 1-10-2000 or thereafter.

Sir,

Vide BSNL HQr letter No. 500-85/CA II/ BSNL/EPF/Vol III dated 23-3-2007 and 10-5-2007 it has been clearly spelt out that the TSM regularised on 1-10-2000 or thereafter will come under the purview of GPF and not in EPF scheme. Such TSM are entitled for Presidential orders and Govt. Pensionary benefits. However, the corporate office letter No. 13-2/2010- TE (Pt) dated 8-9-2011 has created avoidable confusion. The CGM, WTP has issued orders for recovery of EPF from such employees by passing all the previous orders. The CGM has conveniently forgotten that the employees entitled for Govt. pension cannot be brought within the purview of EPF scheme. In course of meeting, held on 12-12-2011, we solicited your attention on the issue and handed over our letter No. TF- 24/3-4 dated 9-12-2011 for necessary action. You have been kind enough to ask the GM (Est) sort out the matter.

We must stress that the BSNL letter No. 13-2/2010- TE (Pt) dated 8-9-2011, is most likely to create further complications in the field.

Therefore, we request you to please get the matter clarified that the EPF scheme cannot be introduced in respect of such personnel who have been extended POS
