Respected Madam,


Vide our letter No.-TF-6/7, dt-26-12-2018. We have solicited the kind attention of Hon'ble Prime Minister of India for his intervention for ensuring Financial viability of the BSNL. It was followed up further by another petition No.-TF-6/7, dt-07-03-2019. The necessary copies of the said petitions are enclosed herewith for your kind perusal and favourable action. The Prime Minister office vide ID No.-PMO PG/D/2019/0003015, dt-03-01-2019 (copy enclosed) has sent the said petitions to the DOT for action. The union is to get a reply from the DOT as desired by PMO.

It is stated that at the time of formation of BSNL the DOT signed agreement on 08-09-2000 with the two federations. Sequel to which the Govt assured and took Cabinet decision for keeping the BSNL financially strong and viable. A copy of agreement dt-08-09-2000 as well as GOM decisions are enclosed for ready reference. We are sorry to state the commitments have been ignored by Govt, DOT, and the financial health of the PSU has now worsened. The various concessions were not only withdrawn one by one but the BSNL has been burdened with extra and unjust burdens. The employees are naturally alarmed over the present developments. The DOT instead of extending financial help is not even settling the claims of the company. The PSU long ago surrendered BWA spectrums but the interests on the money deposits have not yet been paid to company by the DOT. Similarly, The MTNL is not paying the claims of BSNL. The assets have not been transferred by the DOT to BSNL even after 18 years but it is required to borne all the liabilities. The DOT which incorporated various concessions, commitments and points for financial viability in the Cabinet Note dt- 25-09-2000 have been completely forgotten and ignored.

We, therefore implore upon you to please intervene to ensure that the commitments and assurances signed in agreement on 08-09-2000 between two federations and DOT are honoured and acted upon failing which the very credibility of the Govt, Administry Ministry, will be doubted in future.
