- Number of active wireless subscribers (on the date of peak VLR#) in August, 2023 was 1043.38 million.

I. Broadband Subscriber

 As per the information received from 1,087 operators in August,
2023 in comparison to 1,055
Operator in July 2023, the total Broadband Subscribers increased from 868.20 million at the end of July-23 to 876.53 million at the end of August-23 with a monthly growth rate of 0.96%. Segment-wise broadband subscribers and their monthly growth rates are as below:



• Top five service providers constituted 98.35% market share of the total broadband subscribers at the end of August-23. These service providers were Reliance Jio Infocomm Ltd 455.33 million, Bharti Airtel 253.86 million, Vodafone Idea 125.55 million, BSNL 25.12 million and Atria Convergence 2.19 million.

Service Provider-wise Market Share of Broadband (wired + wireless) Services as on 31st August, 2023




- As on 31st August, 2023, the top five <u>Wired</u> Broadband Service providers were Reliance Jio Infocomm Ltd 9.59 million, Bharti Airtel 6.87 million, BSNL 3.71 million, Atria Convergence Technologies 2.19 million and Hathway Cable & Datacom 1.12 million.
- As on 31st August, 2023, the top five <u>Wireless</u> Broadband Service providers were Reliance Jio Infocom Ltd 445.73 million, Bharti Airtel 246.99 million, Vodafone Idea 125.54 million, BSNL 21.41 million and Intech Online Pvt. Ltd. 0.24 million.


II. Wireline Subscribers

- Wireline subscribers increased from 30.61 million at the end of July-23 to 30.78 million at the end of August-23. Net increase in the wireline subscriber base was 0.17 million with a monthly growth rate of 0.56%. The share of urban and rural subscribers in total wireline subscribers were 91.24% and 8.76% respectively at the end of August, 2023.
- The Overall Wireline Tele-density in India increased from 2.20% at the end of July-23 to 2.21% at the end of August-23. Urban and Rural Wireline Teledensity were 5.70% and 0.30% respectively during the same period.
- BSNL, MTNL and APSFL, the three PSU access service providers, held 30.02% of the wireline market share as on 31st August, 2023. Detailed statistics of wireline subscriber base are available at **Annexure-I**.

Access Service Provider-wise Market Share of Wireline Subscribers as on 31st August, 2023




Access Service Provider-wise Net Addition/Decline in Wireline Subscribers during the month of August, 2023



III. Wireless subscriber

Total wireless subscribers increased from 1,146.25 million at the end of July-23, to 1,148.43 million at the end of August-23, thereby registering a monthly growth rate of 0.19%. Wireless subscription in urban areas increased from 628.55 million at the end of July-23 to 629.39 million at the end of August-23 and wireless subscription in rural areas also increased from 517.69 million to 519.04 million during the same period. Monthly growth rate of urban and rural wireless subscription was 0.13% and 0.26% respectively.







Wireless Tele-density in India The increased from 82.38% at the end of July-23 to 82.48% at the end of August-23. The Urban Wireless Tele-density decreased from 127.87% at the end of July-23 to 127.84% at the end of August-23 however Rural Tele-density increased from 57.53% to 57.67% during the same period. The share of urban and rural wireless subscribers in total number of wireless subscribers was 54.80% and 45.20% respectively at the end of August-23. Detailed statistics of wireless subscriber base is available at Annexure-II.

- As on 31st August, 2023, the private access service providers held 91.47% market share of the wireless subscribers whereas BSNL and MTNL, the two PSU access service providers, had a market share of only 8.53%.

Access Service Provider-wise Market Shares in term of Wireless Subscribers as on 31st August, 2023




Net Addition in Wireless Subscribers of Access Service Providers in the month of August, 2023

• Except, U.P.(W), Mumbai, West Bengal, Bihar, Karnataka, Punjab, Haryana and J&K, all other service areas have showed growth in their wireless subscribers during the month of August-23.

IV. Total Telephone Subscribers


• The number of telephone subscribers in India increased from 1,176.85 million at the end of July-23 to 1,179.21 million at the end of August-23, thereby showing a monthly growth rate of 0.20%. Urban telephone subscription increased from 656.47 million at the end of July-23 to 657.47 million at the end of August-23 and the rural subscription also increased from 520.38 million to 521.74 million during the same period. The monthly of growth rates urban and rural telephone subscription were 0.15% and 0.26% respectively during the month of August-23.





• The overall Tele-density in India increased from 84.58% at the end of July-23 to 84.69% at the end of August-23. The Urban Tele-density remained unchanged i.e. 133.55% at the end of August-23 however Rural Tele-density increased from 57.83% at the end of July-23 to 57.97% at the end of August-23. The share of urban and rural subscribers in total number of telephone subscribers at the end of August-23 was 55.76% and 44.24% respectively.

• As may be seen in the above chart, eight LSA have less tele-density than the all India average tele-density at the end of August-23. Delhi service area has maximum tele-density of 274.95% and the Bihar service area has minimum tele-density of 55.82% at the end of August-23.



- As can be seen in the above tables, in wireless segment, on monthly basis all circles have registered growth rate in their subscriber base. On yearly basis, except Circle 'A' and Circle 'B' other circles have registered growth rate in their subscriber base.
- In Wireline segment, on monthly and yearly basis, all circles have registered growth rate in their subscriber base.

VI. Active Wireless Subscribers (VLR Data)


- Out of the total 1,148.43 million wireless subscribers, 1043.38 million wireless subscribers were active on the date of peak VLR in the month of August-23. proportion of active wireless subscribers approximately was 90.85% of the total wireless subscriber base.


Access Service Provider-wise Percentage of VLR Subscribers in the month of August, 2023



 Bharti Airtel has the maximum proportion 99.75% of its active wireless subscribers (VLR) as against its total wireless subscribers (HLR) on the date of

VLR peak in the month of and MTNL August-23 has the minimum proportion of **VLR** 35.83% of its HLR during the same period.





VII. Mobile Number Portability (MNP)

- Intra-service area Mobile number portability (MNP) was implemented first in Haryana service area w.e.f. 25.11.2010 and in the rest of the country w.e.f. 20.01.2011. Inter-Service Area MNP has been implemented in the country w.e.f. 03.07.2015. Now, the wireless telephone subscribers can retain their mobile numbers when they relocate from one service area to another.
- During the month of August-23, a total of 12.67 million requests were received for MNP. Out of total 12.67 million new requests, 7.40 million requests received from Zone-I and 5.26 million requests received from Zone-II. The cumulative MNP requests increased from 864.76 million at the end of July-23 to 877.43 million at the end of August-23, since the implementation of MNP.

- In MNP Zone-I (Northern and Western India), the highest number of requests till date have been received in Uttar Pradesh-East (about 78.54 million) followed by Maharashtra (about 72.31 million) service area.
- In MNP Zone-II (Southern and Eastern India), the highest number of requests till date have been received in Madhya Pradesh (about 67.12 million) followed by Karnataka (about 62.77 million).

VLR Subscribers in the Wireless Segment

Home Location Register (HLR) is a central database that contains details of each mobile phone subscriber that is authorized to use the GSM core network. The HLRs store details of every SIM card issued by the service provider. Each SIM has a unique identifier called an International Mobile Subscriber Identity (IMSI), which is the primary key to each HLR record. The HLR data is stored for as long as a subscriber remains with the service provider. HLR also manages the mobility of subscribers by means of updating their position in administrative areas. It sends the subscriber data to a Visitor Location Register (VLR).

Subscriber numbers reported by the service providers is the difference between the numbers of IMSI registered in service provider's HLR and sum of other figures as given below: -

Visitor Location Register (VLR) is a temporary database of the subscribers who have roamed into the particular area, which it serves. Each base station in the network is served by exactly one VLR; hence a subscriber cannot be present in more than one VLR at a time.

If subscriber is in active stage i.e. he is able to send/receive calls/SMSs he is available both in HLR and VLR. However, it may be possible that the subscriber is registered in HLR but not in VLR due to the reason that he is either switched-off or moved out of coverage area, not reachable etc. In such circumstances he will be available in HLR but not in VLR. This causes difference between subscriber number reported by the service providers based on HLR and numbers available in VLR.

The VLR subscriber data calculated here is based on active subscribers in VLR on the date of Peak subscriber number in VLR of the particular month for which the data is being collected. This data is to be taken from the switches having the purge time of not more than 72 hours.
