Sir,

Kindly refer to our letter No.-TF-1/1(c-8),dt-04-07-2019 in response to Corporate office communication containing the Advisory issued by "SR" Cell. We are now in receipt of BSNL HQR letter No.-BSNL/6-1/SR/2018, dt-09th July, 2019.


It is stated that we are continuously drawing the attention of management to the effect that the claims of employees are not being settled. This is generating avoidable resentment amongst the workers. The administration has utilized the services of Contract Labourers in the maintenance work but the wages have not been paid to them for last six months.

The allowances, J and K special allowance etc apart from medical claims are not being paid to the employees. You will agree such state of affairs is bound to create heat amongst the workers. The suppression of voice in the situation will definitely be counterproductive.

We shall feel obliged in case steps are taken to settle the claims of staff to maintain harmony and peace in the PSU.
