With the approval of Competent Authority it has been decided to hold the online Limited Internal Competitive Examination (LICE) for promotion to the grade of Telecom Technician (TT) to fill up the vacant posts in the grade of Telecom Technician(TT) under 50 % internal quota for vacancy year 2022 from the eligible working employees. Operational Areas (OAs) wise TT vacancies including unfilled(backlog) vacancies from LICE VY 2021 (which are shown separately) are indicated in Annexure 1. The candidates belonging to an OA will be eligible to apply and considered only for the vacancies notified against that particular OA.

### Note:-

- The number of vacancies mentioned above is tentative and subject to change. Reservation will be effective as per guidelines /policy of Govt Of India/court orders if any.
- Since the Jarnail Singh batch of cases is pending in the Hon'ble Supreme court of II. India, any promotion order issued shall be subject to the outcome of further orders that may be passed by the Supreme court in the said case.
- The LICE for promotion to Telecom Technician(TT) shall be conducted as per III. provisions laid in the Recruitment Rules (RR) of Telecom Technician(TT) circulated vide BSNL Corporate Office Letter No. 250-3/2012-PERS-III dated 19.09.2012 (ANNEXURE-2).
- IV. The scheme & syllabus for this said examination has been circulated vide letter no. 250-74/2001-Pers-III (part) dated 18th Oct 2011 (ANNEXURE-3).
- V. The reservation in promotion for persons with benchmark disabilities (PwBDs) will be applicable as per GOI instructions.
- VI. The crucial date for reckoning the eligibility of candidate for appearing in the said LICE shall be 1st January, 2022 for VY 2022 as per DoPT instructions vide OM no. 22011/4/2013-Estt(D) Dated 08th May 2017.
- 3. Subject to Note (VI) para 2 above, the eligibility for appearing in the above mentioned Limited Internal Competitive Examination shall be as per existing Recruitment Rules of Telecom Technician (TT) issued by cadre controlling authority of

BSNL CO vide their letter no. 250-3/2012-PERS-III dated 19.09.2012. In case of any doubt with regard to eligibility, schemes and syllabus of the examination, the Circles may take up the matter suitably with the cadre controlling authority i.e Establishment Branch of the BSNL CO for necessary clarification.

**4.** There will be a single paper. The details of Papers and Time Table of the examination is as under:

The LICE shall be held in CBT online mode.

- **a.** All the questions will be of Multiple Choice Question (MCQ) type. Each question contains four options and the candidate has to select only one correct answer. There would be negative marking and for each wrong answer 25% of the mark of that question would be deducted.
- b. Minimum qualifying marks prescribed is as under:-

Note: There shall be no further relaxation of marks or any other parameter under any circumstance owing to maintenance of efficiency of administration.

- **5.** The LICE will be held at 17 Circle Head Quarters indicated in **Annexure-4**.
- **6.** The concerned Circles are requested to ensure updating of service particulars from the service book of all probable candidates for the said LICE for timely e-verification of eligibility through ERP.
- 7. The employees, who are eligible in accordance with the eligibility conditions as referred in the Recruitment Rules and who desire to appear in the examination should submit the application through online mode. Applications will be considered through the online registration process only. Therefore, candidates are advised to visit BSNL Intranet site (www.intranet.bsnl.co.in) for any updates regarding the said LICE. All candidates applying for LICE for Telecom Technician (TT) are required to read all the instructions provided on website www.internalexam.bsnl.co.in before filling the online application form. Candidates must have valid E-mail ID and mobile number at the time of on-line registration. After submitting the application on-line, the applicant shall retain a hard & soft copy of the application form for record. Data are also required to be verified in SAP/ ERP.



- **8**. The prescribed examination fee shall be Rs.500/-(Rupees Five Hundred only) for the OC candidates, and Rs. 250/- (Rupees Two Hundred Fifty only) for the SC/ST candidates. The fees shall be paid through on-line mode i.e. Internet Banking, Credit Card, Debit Card etc. Fee once paid for the said LICE shall neither be refunded under any circumstances nor can be held in reserve for any other examination or selection even if the said exam is not conducted due to any administrative reasons. Candidates are requested to ensure their eligibility for the said LICE before applying for the same.
- **9.** Candidates are advised to complete their online registration process well before the last date to avoid last day rush/technical glitches/unforeseen circumstances. Online registration process will not be allowed after the last date and all incomplete registrations will be treated as rejected. Candidates will have to download their online application form. The candidates shall have to download an Admit Card from the BSNL website www.internalexam.bsnl.co.in before the date of the online Test by using their user login credential. The admit card will not be sent either by post or by E-mail. BSNL shall not be responsible for server crash problems or delays occurring on the last day of registration.
- 10. The applicants would be admitted to the examination on the basis of data/information furnished by them during online registration. Candidates are, therefore, once again advised to ensure that they fulfill all eligibility conditions before applying. The applicant must also ensure regarding his parent circle / category while filling the same in online application. In case it is found at a later stage that the information furnished by an applicant is false or an applicant does not fulfill any of the eligibility conditions, the candidature of such applicants shall be cancelled even if the candidate qualifies in the LICE and no correspondence in this regard shall be entertained. Issuance of an admit card/Hall Ticket for the examination will NOT promotion/appointment confer candidates anv right for promotion/appointment will be solely subject to fulfillment of all eligibility conditions & availability of vacancies in the concerned circles/OAs provided by concerned authorities.
- 11. BSNL shall display/provide the questions & provisional answer key (for CBT paper objective type questions) on the www.internalexam.bsnl.co.in, soon after the Exam, for a stipulated period, wherein candidates shall be provided with a suitable format to submit their online grievances/queries on question/answer options only on chargeable basis to discourage unscrupulous grievances and shall be paid through online mode i.e. Internet Banking, Credit Card, Debit Card etc. On the basis of grievance received from candidates, if any, the final answer key & qualifying list shall be deployed as per prevailing guidelines.
- 12. Issuance of candidate response sheet, score card etc. for the said LICE shall NOT confer candidate any right for promotion/appointment etc. The promotion/appointment will be solely subject to fulfillment of all eligibility conditions and magnitude of qualified marks secured vis-à-vis availability of vacancies. The aspect of eligibility shall be solely on Circles and therefore circles should ensure that Service particulars of candidates are up-to-date in all respect to avoid any kind of pre/post exam discrepancies.
- **13**. Nothing other than specified in the Admit card be permitted to be taken inside the examination premises by the candidates. Violation of the instructions at any stage will make the candidate liable for disqualification of the candidature without assigning any reason thereof.
- **14.** All concerned Circles are requested to arrange for the pre exam training to aspiring SC/ST/Minority candidates for aforesaid LICE, as per admissible rules.



- **15**. The concerned circles shall constitute an examination conducting team with suitable no. of members, wherein an Executive/Officer not below the rank of **GM** (preferably from HR/Admin sections) would be the Examination Co-ordinator.
- **16**. Examination Coordinator then shall nominate the Superintendent (ES) not below the rank of DGM or equivalent. The Examination Coordinator shall also depute Examination Observer (EO) at every exam centre irrespective of numbers of candidates. The EO should not be below the rank of AGM/DE/EE or equivalent. The Examination Observer (EO) would submit the report to the examination Co-ordinator. The Examination Co-ordinator shall also depute one nodal officer who are responsible for e-verification of data of candidates in SAP/ERP after verifying it from the service book. The duties and responsibilities of Examination Co-ordinator (EC), Examination Superintendent (ES) and Examination Observer (EO)/nodal officer (e-verification) will be intimated separately.

The custodian of the service book shall ensure all aspects while verifying the eligibility and shall be sole responsibility of eligibility verifying authority.
- **19**. Circles are requested to bring this notification to the notice of all working eligible employees.
- **20.** BSNL reserves the right to modify/amend any of the terms & conditions of this recruitment at any point of time.

## Recruitment Rules of Telecom Mechanic in BSNL

New Delhi, the 19th September 2012

### 1. Short Title and commencement:

- (i) With the approval of BSNL Board and in supercession of the Recruitment Rules of Telecom Mechanic-2002, the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Telecom Mechanic in BSNL are hereby made, namely
- (ii) These rules may be called the Telecom Mechanic (Recruitment) Rules, 2012.
- (iii) These rules shall come into force from the date of their publication and shall also be applicable to all Limited Departmental Competitive Examinations to be notified in future after publication of these Recruitment Rules by the Company.
- 2. <u>Definition:</u> In these Rules unless the context otherwise requires,
  - (i) <u>Company:</u> Means the Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited (A Government of India Enterprise) having its Registered Office at Bharat Sanchar Bhawan, Janpath, New Delhi.
  - (ii) <u>Board:</u> Means the Board of Directors of the Company and includes in relation to the exercise of powers any Committee of the Board/Management or any other Officer of the Undertaking to whom the Board delegates any of its power.
- 3. Application: These Rules shall apply to the posts as specified in Column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these Rules.

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- Number of posts, Classification and scale of pay—The number of the said post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Column 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed.
- The method of Recruitment, age limit, qualifications etc.——
  The method of recruitment, age limit, qualification and other matters relating to the said post shall be specified in Column 5 to 13 of the Schedule annexed.

## **Disqualification**----No Person:-

- a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
- b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted marriage with any person,

Shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts;

- 7. Pre-appointment training:

  The selected candidates before appointment shall have to successfully undergo the prescribed training for such period as may be specified from time to time by the BSNL. The officials who fail to complete the training successfully will not be promoted/appointed as Telecom Mechanic.
- 8. <u>Liability to serve under the P&T (Territorial Army)</u>
  Signal Units:----All candidates shall, if so required, be liable to serve in the Posts and Telegraphs (territorial Army) Signal Units as provided in the Territorial Army Act 1948 (56 of 1948) and the rules made there under.
- 9. Saving: ---- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limited and other concession required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-Serviceman and other special category of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

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## 10. <u>Initial constitution:</u>-

- (i) All officials holding the posts of Telecom Mechanics on regular basis in the erstwhile DoT/DTS/DTO before commencement of these rules and those who have been absorbed in Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited shall be deemed to have been appointed as Telecom Mechanic in BSNL.
- (ii) The continuous regular service of officials referred to in sub-rule 10(i) above before the commencement of these rules shall count for the purpose of Probation, Qualifying service for promotion, Confirmation and Pension.
